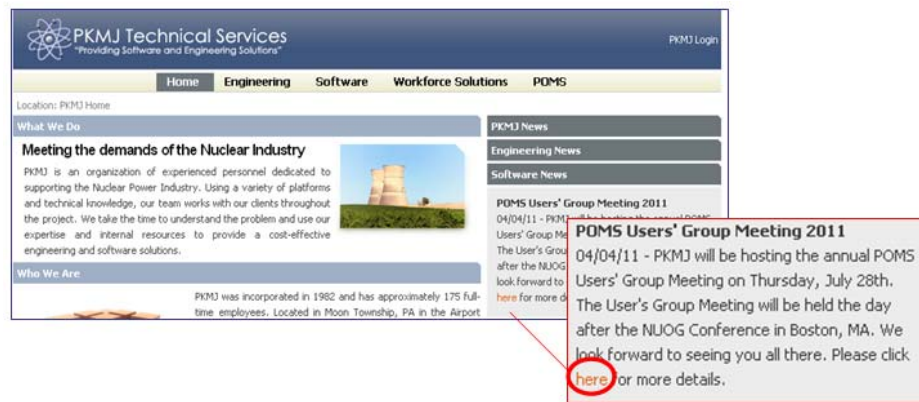


# POMS Users' Group Registration


2. From the POMS Users Group Meeting page, click the "Register" button on the left of the screen.

# Obsolescence Manager Enhancement

For 2011, sites that have subscribed to Obsolescence Manager will now have enhanced capability to override the site Obsolescence Value Ranking (OVR)! This new enhancement allows the site to customize the priority ranking of select obsolescence challenges.

Some of the key advantages of this feature:

- Allows the site to more accurately track and prioritize high vulnerability/high impact obsolete items
- Provides a mechanism to down prioritize obsolescence issues that yield lower impact to the station due to site specific stocking strategy or maintenance philosophy

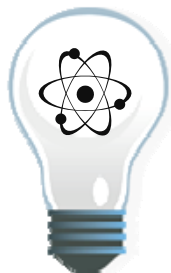


## Industry Think Tank

## Vendor Contacts Update

Our contacting team continues to follow up with vendors that have committed to provide us with results, as well as researching and communicating with any newly identified vendors. We continually strive for 100% vendor support. As with previous years, we will be contacting each vendor and submitting your model information for verification and updated obsolescence information.

There are currently a select number of vendors that we have been unable to gain support from. Although these vendors may not fully support the POMS data collection process, they represent a very limited subset out of the 14,000+ vendors within the POMS database, many of which continue to support the project on an annual basis.

To further engage both vendors and the POMS utility members has included the creation of a utility subcommittee. This subcommittee was created and endorsed by the POMS utility members in a continued effort for POMS to maintain the needed data to identify and manage obsolescence at their plant.

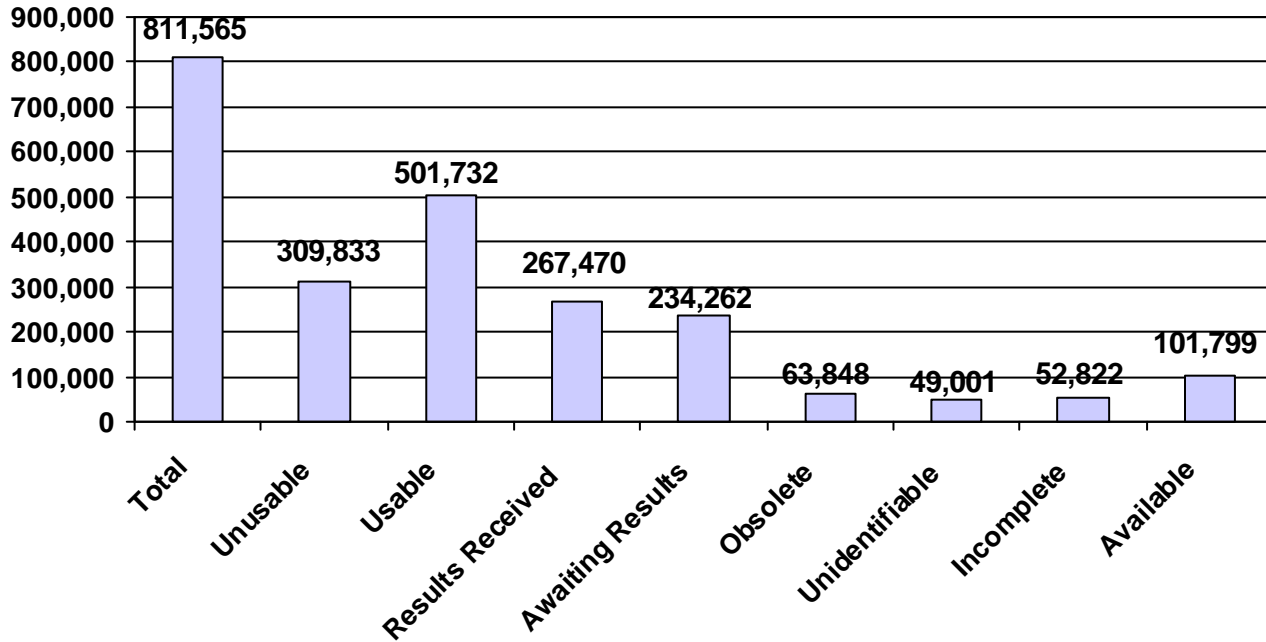

## Model Number Results [as of 31 March 2011]



- **Total:** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations received from each site.
- **Unusable:** Number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations with unknown or invalid values for the manufacturer and/or model number fields
- **Scope:** Total - Unusable = Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations in scope for the POMS Vendor Contacting process.
- **Completed:** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations POMS team contacted and received results for.
- **Remaining:** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations POMS team contacted and are awaiting results from the vendors.
- **Obsolete (24% of Completed):** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations POMS Vendor Contacts identified as obsolete (no longer manufactured).
- **Unidentifiable (19% of Completed):** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations vendors could not identify as valid model numbers.
- **Incomplete (18% of Completed):** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations that were recognized by the manufacturer as a partial number, but a positive identification could not be made.
- **Available (39% of Completed):** Total number of unique manufacturer/model number combinations POMS Vendor Contacts identified as available for purchase (not obsolete).
